

## GERMAN ROACH RESIDENTIAL PREPARATION LETTER

Dear Client,

Your home has been inspected and roaches have been found. The following items need to be done prior to treatment:

- **Remove all items from every Kitchen and Bathroom cupboards, drawer and shelves, and counter tops. This includes china, cabinets and shelves containing cookbooks. Failure to empty out every cupboard, drawer and shelf will compromise the technician's ability to treat successfully and may prolong the time it takes to eliminate the problem**
  - Place dishes, silverware, pots and pans in another room either in plastic bags or covered with sheets. Any food removed from the cabinets must either be in sealed containers or placed in the refrigerator.
  - Remove shelf paper (except for Contact Paper) and clean the cupboards prior to the treatment. Remove all items from medicine cabinets and from under sink areas.
  - If pests have been seen in closets, remove all items from these areas.
  - Stove tops and ovens should be free of food with the all surfaces cleaned as well.
- All areas above should be cleaned prior to the technician's arrival. This means using a vacuum and a cleaning solvent on the surfaces outlined above.
- Remove all pets from the premises. Cover all aquariums and unplug their air pumps. We are not responsible for your fish or pets.
- Please allow all surfaces to dry before putting things away. Please do not clean again after the treatment has been made. You can remove or contaminate the applications made rendering the treatment potentially useless.
- **Also, no attempts should be made to self-treat. Doing so can cause the roaches to hide deeper in the walls and makes it take longer to resolve the issue. It can also push the pests form one unit to the next.**
